**Consultation: Ashlawn School Academy Trust Admissions Arrangements**

Ashlawn School Academy Trust is beginning the formal process to extend its annual intake from 256 students per year group to 280 places from September 2013. I should like to consult you on this proposal.

For a number of years Ashlawn School has been oversubscribed. In an effort to meet additional demand, Ashlawn Trust is planning to increase the number of Year 7 places to 280.

It is the intention of the Academy Trust to increase the Pupil Admission Numbers (PAN) over a phased period of time whilst formalising the 90 places in our grammar stream by selecting 90 students via the 11+ external examination.

**Why Change?**

This proposal to increase capacity from 256 to 280 places in Years 7-11 is necessary as it will help us to provide a truly comprehensive education. Currently Ashlawn School's admission's profile is not representative and this increase would ensure that we draw on a more comprehensive range of abilities. In addition, further housing in Hillmorton is expected and this increase will help to meet the growing demand for places at the school.

**What is the Proposed Timetable?**

December 2011 - February 2012: Consultation with parents, the local community, schools and other interested organisations.

February 2012: In light of the consultation, the Academy Trust will decide on proceeding with the proposed admission arrangements.
