KS5 Music

When you arrive in year 12 we expect you are able to meet the following minimum requirements:

- To be able to perform to a good standard (grade 4 or above)
- To be able to read music and have a firm grasp of the rudiments of music theory
- To be able to produce original compositions
- To be able to listen analytically to music

To support you with this we ask that you produce a portfolio of work over the summer which includes the following:

- A copy of your grade certificate and feedback sheet OR an mp3 recording of you playing/singing 2 contrasting pieces
- A copy of your grade 4 music theory certificate OR completion of a grade 4 music theory paper which you can buy online. Any examination board is fine. (You can use musictheory.net or teoria.com to help you with any problems you have.)
- A score and recording of an original composition
- A listening diary which contains pieces from a variety of genres including jazz, pop and classical. (Example included)
