

## 16-19 Tuition Fund 2021-22

The post 16 catch up funding was used by:

- English tuition to ensure students who did not succeed in achieving GCSE English in Year 11 achieved a GCSE
  qualification in English. English tuition was timetabled in a small group of 5 students from September to
  January.
- Maths tuition to ensure students who did not succeed in achieving GCSE Maths in Year 11 achieved a Maths qualification. Maths tuition was timetabled in a small group from September to May.
- Support for mental health and wellbeing. Students received timetabled one to one support sessions on a
  weekly basis. Student support is ongoing and starts in September of Year 12 and continues until students
  leave at the end of Year 13.

Students are selected to receive the additional support based on whether they have achieved a pass grade in Year 11 for GCSE English and Maths. Students who have received support for mental health and wellbeing are referred in Sixth Form to receive extra in school support.

The proposal for the use of post 16 catch up funding will be to:

- English tuition to ensure students who did not succeed in achieving GCSE English in Year 11 achieved a GCSE qualification in English. English has one student retaking the subject.
- Maths tuition to ensure students who did not succeed in achieving GCSE Maths in Year 11 achieved a Maths qualification. Maths has 7 students retaking the subject.
- Support for mental health and wellbeing.



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
