



## LE FUTUR (will)

● **Comment on le forme?** l'infinif + les terminaisons du futur *(Re verbs, take off the -e)*

● **Les terminaisons?** *(these are like the verb 'avoir' in the present tense)*

JE+ -ai	NOUS + -ons
TU + -as	VOUS + -ez
IL/ELLE/ON + -a	ILS/ELLES + -ont

**EG** : je jouerai = I will play      nous partirons = we will leave      elle vendra = she'll sell

● **EXCEPTIONS?** Oui!

ÊTRE (to be): je **serai** / il **sera** ...

AVOIR (to have): j'**aurai** / nous **aurons**...

FAIRE (to do): je **ferai**

ALLER (to go): j'**irai**

POUVOIR (be able to): je **pourrai**

VOULOIR (want): je **voudrai**

DEVOIR (have to): je **devrai**

TENIR=to hold: je **tiendrai**

SAVOIR = to know: je **saurai**

VOIR = to see: je **verrai**

(DE)VENIR = to (be)come: je **(de)viendrai**

IL FAUT = one must.....**IL FAUDRA**

IL Y A = there is.....**IL Y AURA**

## LE CONDITIONNEL (would)

● **Comment on le forme?** l'infinif + les terminaisons du conditionnel *(Re verbs, take off the -e)*

● **Les terminaisons?** *(these are the same as the imperfect...)*

JE+ -ais	NOUS + -ions
TU + -ais	VOUS + -iez
IL/ELLE/ON + -ait	ILS/ELLES + -aient

**EG** : je jouerais = I would play      nous partirions = we would leave      elle vendrait = she'd sell

● **EXCEPTIONS?** Oui!

ÊTRE (to be): je **serais** / il **serait** ...

AVOIR (to have): j'**aurais** / nous **aurions**...

FAIRE (to do): je **ferais**

ALLER (to go): j'**irais**

POUVOIR (be able to): je **pourrais**

VOULOIR (want): je **voudrais**

DEVOIR (have to): je **devrais**

TENIR=to hold: je **tiendrais**

SAVOIR = to know: je **saurais**

VOIR = to see: je **verrais**

(DE)VENIR = to (be)come: je **(de)viendrais**

IL FAUT = one must.....**IL FAUDRAIT**

IL Y A = there is.....**IL Y AURAIT**
