Before Results Day

Most students will access their own results on results day via Edulink or by coming in to collect them. If you are away on results day and unlikely to be able to access Edulink, you can nominate a family member or friend to collect them on your behalf but you will need to do this in advance of the day. **Because these results belong to you, we cannot share them with anybody else without your permission**, so if you do not let us know then we will not release them. The person collecting on your behalf must bring a photo ID with them that matches the name you have provided.

Results will be available on Edulink from 09:00. We will **not** be able to email results to students or parents.

When you collect your results, you will be given an envelope which will contain a statement of results (see example below) and a letter detailing next steps. For A Level, the sixth form team will be on hand to discuss any UCAS or university queries or to support with clearing if required. For GCSE, the letter will either confirm your place at Ashlawn Sixth Form if you applied (and inform you whether your results enable you to take your first choice options or that you would need to make a change), or let you know that unfortunately you have not met the entry criteria. Again, staff will be on hand throughout the morning to support and answer any queries.

Sixth Form place (Y11 only)

If you have applied for a place at Ashlawn Sixth Form, you will also be given a slip with further instructions. The slip will direct you as follows:

ALL CRITERIA MET

Congratulations! You have met the requirements for Ashlawn Sixth Form and for your chosen subjects. You just need to sign to accept your place.

SOME CRITERIA MET

You have met the requirements for Ashlawn Sixth Form, so we are pleased to confirm your place. However, you have not met the entry criteria for some or all of your chosen subjects, so will need to discuss alternative options

CRITERIA NOT MET

Unfortunately, you have not met the entry criteria for Ashlawn Sixth Form, so we are unable to offer you a place. You will be able to speak with a member of staff to discuss your available options.

After Results

There are a number of “post-results services” available to you if you are unhappy with your results or think there has been an error. Most of these come with a cost attached so please make sure you discuss with your parents and with staff before making a decision. All costs are available on the post-results services form linked below but in general they are between £50 and £70 **per script (paper)**.

Clerical Check - if you think there might have been an error in your result (for instance, a paper being missing or a total mark being incorrect), you can request a clerical check. This will check all of the procedures but does not involve the marks themselves being checked.

Mark Review - this checks whether there has been an administrative or marking error on the paper, for example if the mark scheme has not been applied correctly. It is not a full re-mark of the paper, it simply checks that the marks that have been awarded are reasonable in line with the mark scheme. You can request a priority review if you have a university place that has been declined because of your grade(s), in which case we will need your UCAS number as part of the request.

Access to Script - this provides a scanned version of your marked exam script to you. It may be useful to access this first if you are considering a mark review, and a teacher might be able to look through your script(s) and see if they can spot anything that might need a review.
